**WHAT/WHO:** First Saturday *Art Stroll* from one end of Canal Street to the other, including over 75 artists represented at The Hub on Canal. HubArt Connection exhibition during *Gallery Walk* from 4-7pm at The Hub on Canal. Artist talk at 6pm in the Gallery. In the series *Observations from the Natural World*, artist Leslie Holland combines her interest in botany and chiaroscuro/sculptural techniques, which were developed by Renaissance and Baroque masters, and as expressed through Classical Realism to create forms that emerge from darkness. Her primary drawing subjects are the classical botanical forms of the pear and apple, as well as voluminous floral shapes, which do not rely on color for recognition. Her affinity

for typeface design and typography led to developing a series of letter- and number-form drawings based upon classical typefaces, reinterpreted in graphite. Type forms push through the ambiguous mist of shadow and light to be partially or wholly revealed.

In 2001, Marc started the first New Smyrna Beach Jazz Festival and this September will mark the 17th year for that great event.

For this concert, Marc will be joined by Mark Mckee on keyboards, John Pellegrino on the upright bass and Wendell Raulerson on drums.
