**PROSPECTUS – December 2017 ART COMPETITION**

- Theme: Choose your Muse... Ode to the Masters
- Dates: Saturday, December 2, 2017– Sunday, December 31, 2017
- Opening Reception: Saturday, Dec. 2 from 4PM to 7PM. Cash prizes to be awarded.
- Entry Fee: \$30.00 (One piece of artwork per artist.)
- Open to: Artists at The Hub on Canal, The Artist's Workshop, The Art League of Daytona, and the Flagler Art League
- Entry Procedure: Artists must submit intent to enter show by mailing or dropping off the top part of the form on the last page of this prospectus **with entry fee by October 6, 2017**, to The Hub on Canal.
- Please attach the bottom part of the form to the back of your artwork.** NOTE: 2 D artwork must be properly wired and ready to hang. ***Work not properly wired will not be accepted.***
- Drop Off: **Mon. November 27, 2017, from 10am-2pm**  
If your work is juried out you will be notified by phone and must come to pick up your work on Tues. between 10 AM and 5PM.
- Pick Up **Tuesday, January 2, 2018, between 10AM-5PM,**
- Judge: Ed Hall

A Jacksonville, Florida native, Ed Hall received his B.D. in Graphic Design, and his M.F.A. in Painting from the University of Florida. During college, he did political cartoons and illustrations for UF's school newspaper. After college, he worked for several weekly publications, finally settling at The Baker County Press in Macclenny (just outside Jacksonville) where he continues to work as the weekly cartoonist. Hall has won 10 Florida Press Awards, 3 Newsmaker Awards, and numerous fine art awards in national and international competitions. In 2003, he was presented the 53rd Annual Green Eyeshade Award for weekly cartoons by The Society of Professional Journalists. He has also won the Florida Press Club Award four times (2003 & 2006, 2008 and 2012).

Hall has been the owner of *Design Alternatives*, a home-based residential design service, for 25 years. He has been an adjunct professor of drawing at Flagler College in St. Augustine and The

University of North Florida, Jacksonville. His cartoons and political illustrations have been featured in various national publications including The Washington Post, The New York Times and CNN Headline News. His work is also widely distributed overseas. In 2003 he was asked to join Artizans, a Canadian based syndicate. Through Artizans, Ed's cartoons appear weekly in newspapers across North America.

His artwork has been displayed both regionally and nationally; most recently at the American University Museum in Washington DC and the Warhol Museum in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania. He was also awarded a one-person show at the Reddi-arts Gallery in Jacksonville Florida. Other recent awards include best of show in ***Behind the Mask, Inside the Head*** a Jacksonville Coalition for the Visual Arts exhibition in 1997, and best of show for ***Figures of the Millenium***, a St. Augustine Art Association show held in 1999.

Hall is represented in Jacksonville by The Vault at 1930. His work is also held in the permanent collection of the St. Augustine Art Association. He currently resides in Jacksonville with his wife Emmy.

### **Show Policies:**

1. All work must be original. All work submitted must be original works, and the Artist must have all necessary rights of use and reproduction. If any third party disputes the Artist's claims of ownership, originality, or copyrights, The Hub will not mediate the dispute or become involved. The work at issue will be removed and returned to the Artist. No refund will be provided. Artwork must have been created within two years of December 2, 2017.
2. Art work can be 2D or 3D. Work can be a 24" maximum on any side for 2D and 3D work (this includes the frame). Only one piece of art can be submitted per artist. ***NOTE: Work that exceeds size restriction will not be accepted.***
3. Artwork must be for sale and 2D work must be framed or on gallery wrapped canvas/board and ready for hanging--wire with D-ring—or ready for presentation if 3D. And work must be properly labeled with the artist's name, title of piece, and price on the back of the artwork.
4. It is recommended that all participating artists attend the Opening Reception at The Hub during First Saturday Gallery Walk on December 2, 2017 from 4-7pm.
5. All sales will be reconciled within a month of the show closing and check will be mailed to artists for any sales, less 20% commission. Artist should include legal name on submission if different from working name.
6. All work must be picked up on the days indicated for pickup. The Hub on Canal is not responsible for damage during storage to any work not picked up after posted pick up date. Any art not picked up within 14 days of the show closure will become the property of The Hub on Canal.
7. The Hub on Canal will make every effort to carefully handle and protect work. However, The Hub on Canal cannot be held liable for damage to work or any personal injury sustained while participating in this exhibition.
8. The Hub on Canal is not liable for theft of any work displayed within the premises. The Hub will make every reasonable effort to maintain a secure premise for our artists. However, the Hub does not insure any artwork displayed. Artists are welcome to provide their own insurance.
