Relief Printmaking at The Hub on Canal Saturday, August 3, 10am-2pm, with Jennifer Harper




**The Art of Abstract Poured Acrylics at The Hub on Canal


**Quick Draw – A Drop-In Drawing Class at The Hub on Canal



***Back to the Future* (1985) at The Hub on Canal**
Friday, August 16, 5:45-9pm, Art in the Form of Film: with Paul Marino

Has there ever been a more fun romp through the past? *Back to the Future* starring Michael J Fox is as enjoyable today, more than 30 years after its initial release in 1985, as when it took a 30-year ride back to the 1950s. With hilarious references to Ronald Reagan, Tab cola, and the golden age of television, *Back to the Future* holds up well upon multiple viewings. Beyond pure entertainment, the film also addresses the fragile destinies of our parents, and how easily each of us could become a rapidly fading image in a would-be family portrait. Director Robert Zemeckis, who went on direct *Who Framed Roger Rabbit* (1989) and *Forest Gump* (1994) for which he won the Academy Award for Best Director, establishes himself here as a special-effects wizard with the storytelling skills of Spielberg. Instructor Paul Marino will introduce the film, raise questions to ponder and host a post-viewing discussion.




